**Writing**

Writing based around Viking Myths and Legends.

**Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling**

Year 5 common exception words- throughout  
 Recognise and spell words ending in -ant, -ance/-ancy, -ent, -ence/-ency.  
 Spell some words with 'silent' letters, e.g. knight, psalm, solemn.  
 Recap year 4 grammar and revision of word classes taught so far  
 Use inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate direct speech  
 Link ideas across paragraphs using adverbials for time, place and numbers  
 Use expanded noun phrases to convey complicated information concisely  
 Create and punctuate complex sentences using ed opening clauses  
 Create complex sentences by using relative clauses with relative pronouns  
 Use commas to mark clauses in complex sentences.
