What makes someone special is what makes them different. What matters isn't what they look like. They should only be judged on what they are like inside. Fatima—Year 6

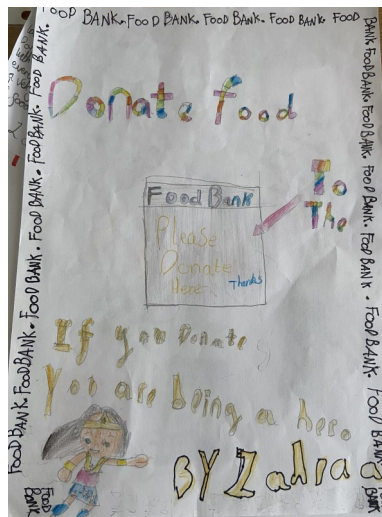
It doesn't matter what people look like. We are all unique! Ethan—Year 3
