Car Park and Playground

Can we ask all parents to park carefully in marked bays and not across 2 bays, otherwise there is not enough room for all at home time. Please keep your children in your sight on the school grounds at all times, especially when chatting to friends, as we have had instances of children running in front of moving cars.

Children should NOT be left unsupervised on the playground in the morning before the school door opens at 8.25am. We have continued to open school this early post-Covid to assist working parents, however it is quite clear that some children are being left alone on the playground before 8.25am. This is not safe and school is not responsible for supervising your children before the start of the school day. Breakfast club is available in the school dining room from 7.30am and can be used on an ad-hoc basis when you need it. Any child unsupervised on the playground before 8.25am next week will be taken to breakfast club until the start of the school day.
