Plain white ankle socks

Black shoes

Boys

Grey shorts (from Grays)

White short sleeve shirt

School tie

Navy V-neck jumper trimmed with royal blue

Navy blazer trimmed with royal blue braid

Navy ankle socks

Black shoes, not boots.

Navy ankle socks
